

Getting Here

Paintbox Bistro is located at 555 Dundas St E. Toronto, ON. M5A 2B7 (Dundas & Sackville) on the South East corner

Below is a map of the closest major intersection, which is Dundas and Parliament.





From Dundas station take the 505 Broadview Station Via Dundas bus to **Dundas & Sackville**

From Broadview station take the 505 Dundas West Station via Dundas bus to Dundas & Sackville



Subway

Two closest stations are Dundas to the west and Broadview to the east



Take a taxi to Dundas and Sackville



& Wheeltrans

Wheeltrans can exit at Dundas and Sackville



Parking

There is street parking on Dundas or also in the Fresh co lot at Dundas and Parliament.

Arriving

This is what our venue looks like. It is also our front of house, which is located just outside the venue.



Front of House

You may need to visit our Front of House if you want to:

- Indicate that you require priority seating
- Indicate that you require alternative seating
- Indicate that you require accessible seating

Before the show

Glass doors separate the performance space from the rest of the bistro. They are to the right of the bistro area. Enter through them.




This is where you will sit and watch the show. You can sit in whichever seat you like!




Washroom
