

Heartbreak is universal. Everyone has dealt with it in some form, and it affects us all differently. For some, it takes a toll on one's mental health.

Broken Hearted Girl is an honest and soul-baring visual album in three acts. A journey through three relationships that have shaped and shifted our heroine. Over the course of nine original songs and three interludes, the once independent **Selena Vyle** sings about finding love at first sight, and how sudden heartbreak triggered her depression and panic attacks. She carries her mental health issues into her next two relationships and navigates trying to find happiness in love (and self love) despite her brain working against her.

These videos will take you on an emotional and visual rollercoaster, exploring musical styles from electro-pop to musical theatre, and outdoor locations around Toronto's West End like Ontario Place, Roy Thompson Hall and the streets of Parkdale. Every location has a special meaning to our queen and directly relates to each relationship sung about.

Developed by a team of mostly drag artists working tirelessly over the course of one month to create twelve original tracks. Featuring original music composed by drag performer **Kitty Creature** (additional music by recording artist **Maya Killtron**), shot and edited by drag artist and director of photography **Gei Ping Hohl**, plus styling, makeup, poster and additional artwork by **Spencer Wilson** (drag queen **Sapphire**). Lyrics, vocals, performance and directing by **Selena Vyle** (otherwise known as comedian and actor **Nicky Nasrallah**).
