Frog in Hand began with a cast of frogs performing circus tricks under the artistic direction of sisters, Noelle Hamlyn and Colleen Snell, who were one and five years old at the time. From this whimsical debut springs our firm belief that art begins in humble places – including the mud and grass of our own backyards. Although we are now a diverse collective of storytellers - dancers, choreographers, musicians, actors, spoken word poets, designers and visual artists - we are still inspired by where we find ourselves. We create site-specific experiences as platforms for artistic exchange, collaboration and social change. We contribute by sharing resources and knowledge through creation, performance and education.
