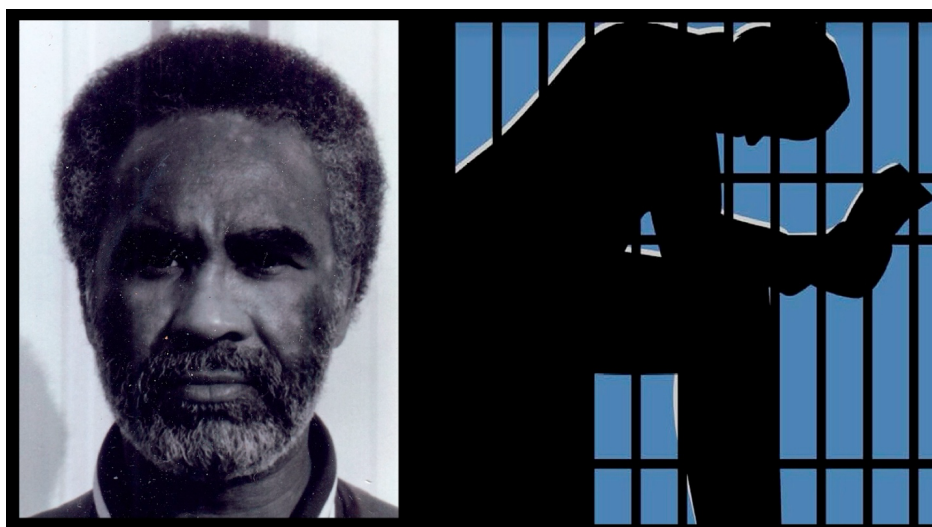

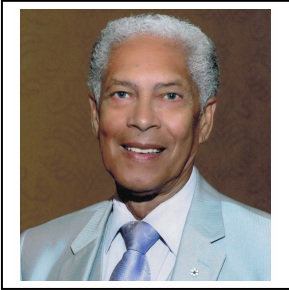
## **Run Time**

Please be advised that JUSTICE FOR MAURICE HENRY CARTER re-enacts a shooting as described by a witness. An actor claps their hands to represent gun shots. Some actors will raise their voices. Both in life and here in the theatre, everyone was physically okay after. And the witness felt better after sharing their story. There are a few scenes where an actor talks about life in prison and mentions the word "violence" but there are no graphic descriptions. There is also a mention of a man being stabbed. There is no graphic description and the man lived and the person who stabbed him apologized.

## Set



The set is six black folding chairs and a brown wooden bench. One each side of the stage, there are three chairs beside each other. When seated, the actors on opposite sides of the stage face each other.

## Costumes



Maurice wears a blue dress shirt and grey dress pants. Doug wears a lighter blue shirt than Maurice and greyish/black jeans. The chorus members are all dressed in black. Two in black dress shirts in pants; two in black tops and black leggings; and one in a black dress.
