- A short speech from the stage about the performance
- Introductions from the creator-performers and a few examples of the characters they'll play
- This Relaxed Performance is just like our other shows except:
- -You can get up at any time, walk around, go to the washroom
- -There is a quiet space in the lobby just outside the theatre you can leave and visit it if you need a break and return anytime, for any reason
- -Feel free to make noise this is a non-shushing show! Outbursts, fidgeting, and babies crying are all okay
- -Today the music is turned down and will ease in and out, not snap on loudly. If it is too loud, covering your ears is okay, we won't mind!
- -The house lights and stage lights will not go to black and will fade in and out, not snap on or off at any time.

We really want you to feel comfortable to take care of your needs - don't worry about disrupting the actors.

Conor Bradbury (he/him)

Conor is an actor, improvisor and improv teacher.



Julian Frid (he/him)

Julian is an actor, comedian, writer and teacher.



Kait Morrow (they/them)

Kait is a trans/non-binary actor, comedian and award-winning puppeteer.



Seann Murray (he/him)

Seann is an actor, improvisor and stage manager.



Victoria Laberge (she/her)

Victoria is the Producer of the show - she will be in the audience with you!



Noah Farberman (he/him)

Noah is our Stage Manager - he will be upstairs in the booth with our technician.

## What to Expect from the Show

This is a Sketch Comedy show – we will be performing many short, funny scenes. Most of the scenes will not be related to the ones before, but sometimes there will be characters returning in sketches that connect to each other.

Each performer will play a number of different characters, including Frank Sinatra, superheroes, a James Bond-style hero, little kids, and many more.







There will be a few small amounts of violence – we will show you an example at the beginning of the show, and you can close your eyes if you'd like.

There are a few puppets, which we'll show to you at the beginning of the show.





Many jokes will be on big signs. We usually don't read them out loud, but we will be reading them at the Relaxed Performance. We'll give you an example of what that looks like at the beginning of the show.

There is one instance of nudity where you will see Julian's butt.
