kiskisiwin nimihko (remembering my blood) is a flower-beadwork calendar of events of a Métis woman's life and the matriarchal michif stories held in her blood-bonememory. A love letter and ode (kayas nikamon) to a çapan, (a 3rd great-grandmother) who lived her life as a mother, a buffalo hunter, and as part of the Résistance who went to war along with her nation's kin against 'la maudite police' in Batoche in 1885.
