## THE STORY

With Love and a Major Organ is originally a stage play. It premiered at the Toronto Fringe Festival in 2012 and was named Outstanding New Play & Outstanding Production (NOW Magazine), Patron's Pick, Best of the Fringe (Torontoist) and extended at the Toronto Arts Centre. Since, it has been performed all over the United States and translated into French (when produced in Paris). The original 60-minute version is <u>published by J.G. Shillingford Publishing</u>. The play has received many accolades, including being part of The Theatre @ Boston Court's Polly Warfield Award-winning season and receiving a nomination for "Best Production" from the Los Angeles Drama Critics' Circle. A feature film inspired by the play, also written by Julia Lederer, was awarded Telefilm Regional Funding, short-listed for the Sundance Feature Development Lab, and a selected for the Whistler Film Festival's Screenwriters' Lab, will go to camera in Vancouver in early 2022.
